Application Instructions and Information

This packet contains forms and instructions for applying to the Clinical Psychology program in the Department of Psychological Science. In addition to applying to the department, you must also apply separately to Ball State's Graduate School (if you are a U.S. citizen) or to Ball State's Rinker Center for International Programs (if you are an international student).

U.S. citizens: Besides submitting an application to the Department of Psychological Science, you must apply to Ball State University's Graduate School. You can complete the Graduate School's application online (go to www.bsu.edu/gradschool). You will be required to submit an application fee before the Graduate School will process your information. On the application form, please *indicate carefully* that you are applying to the Clinical Psychology M.A. program in the Department of Psychological Science; there are other programs at Ball State with similar names. You must be admitted to the Graduate School to be eligible for admission to the department's program; however, acceptance to the Graduate School does not guarantee admission to the department.

International students: Besides submitting an application to the Department of Psychological Science, you must apply to Ball State University's Rinker Center for International Programs. The International Programs website (www.bsu.edu/internationaladmit) will guide you through their application process. On all forms, please *indicate carefully* that you are applying to the Clinical Psychology M.A. program in the Department of Psychological Science; there are other programs at Ball State with similar names.

Required Application Materials for Applying to the Department of Psychological Science

The application deadline for fall semester is the previous March 1. Late applications will be considered only if openings are available after consideration of all applications received by March 1. Please note that the department will not review incomplete applications; you must submit all of the required items. Collect the required materials listed below (except the official report of your GRE scores, which is sent by the Educational Testing Service), put them in one packet, and send them to:

1. Complete and submit the Department of Psychological Science Application form. Before beginning, please carefully read the section below titled "Instructions for Completing the Department Application Form."
2. Print out three copies of the recommendation form included in this packet. Give the forms to three professors or supervisors who can comment in detail on your qualifications for graduate study in psychology, including your academic ability and performance, research skills, clinical experience, and the extent to which your research interests and career goals match those offered by our program. You should not request a recommendation from a nonacademic person unless he or she supervises you in a research or clinical setting. Recommendations from friends and family members are inappropriate. Collect the completed recommendations and enclose them when you submit your application materials. The recommenders should seal the materials in an envelope and sign across the envelope flap.
3. Write a personal statement that discusses your skills, experiences, interests, and reasons for applying to the program. Before beginning, please carefully read the section below titled "Instructions for Writing the Personal Statement."
4. Submit a résumé or vita outlining your education, honors and awards, work or internship experience, research, and other psychology-related experience.
5. Instruct the Educational Testing Service (ETS) to send an official report of your scores on the general test (verbal,

quantitative, and analytic writing sections) of the Graduate Record Examination. We do not require or consider the psychology subject test. Ball State's institution code is 1051. The department code is 2001 for the Clinical Psychology program.

Instructions for Completing the Department Application Form

Items 1 and 2. Report your full legal name, along with any names you have previously used. "Last name" means your family name, and "first name" means your given name.

Item 3. Ball State University is on the semester system. Students in both programs begin their studies during fall semester. Please indicate which year you would like to begin graduate study.

Items 4-5. Self-explanatory.

Item 6. If you have a temporary address (e.g., a school address) that you will leave before the start of the term for which you are applying, enter that address here and specify the date when you will leave. If you do not have a temporary address, leave this item blank.

Item 7. If you entered a temporary address in Item 6, report your permanent address here.

Item 8. Please enter your e mail address carefully and legibly; some characters look similar (e.g., lower case L and the number one). We will use this address to contact you about the status of your application.

Item 9. Remember to send to the Graduate School official transcripts from all colleges and universities you attended, regardless of length of time enrolled or number of credits earned. It is not necessary to submit high school transcripts.

Item 10. Indicate by checking the appropriate box whether you intend to be a full-time or part-time student. A full-time student is one who registers for nine or more credit hours per semester.

Item 11. Indicate here whether you wish to be considered for a graduate assistantship. An assistantship is a job within the department. If you are awarded an assistantship, you receive a partial tuition remission and a stipend. In return, you work 20 hours per week assisting faculty with teaching, research, and/or administrative duties. We have a limited number of assistantships, which are offered to the top students on our ranked admission list. We will let you know if we can give you an assistantship when we contact you about admission.

Item 12. Compute your undergraduate cumulative grade point average (GPA) as follows: First, convert course letter grades to numerical grades using the following scale: A = 4, A- = 3.67, B+ = 3.33, B = 3.00, B- = 2.67, C+ = 2.33, C = 2.00, C- = 1.67, D+ = 1.33, D = 1.00, D- = 0.67, F = 0. Then multiply each numerical grade by the number of credit hours assigned to that course. Add the products, and divide by the total number of credit hours taken. Be sure to include all undergraduate grades, including credits you may have transferred from one institution to another.

Item 13. Follow the instructions in Item 12, but base your calculations on the courses you have taken during your junior and senior years only.

Item 14. Follow the instructions in Item 12, but base your calculations on the psychology courses you have taken.

Item 15. Report all GRE scores that you have earned within the past six years. Your scores will be verified using reports from ETS, but your application may be processed more quickly if you submit your scores on this form.

Item 16. Please follow the instructions on the form.

Item 17. Self-explanatory.
