Tuition

A. Basic Graduate Tuition

Applies to All Graduate Students taking courses on the main Ball State campus, off-campus, short-term, online, or distance education courses.

\$394 per credit hour

B. Non-Resident Tuition

Applies Only to Students who are not legal residents of Indiana.

To calculate, include the hourly rate:

\$684 per credit hour for main campus courses
 \$196 per credit hours for off-campus or short-term courses
 \$196 per credit hour for online or distance education courses
