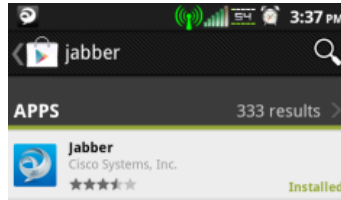


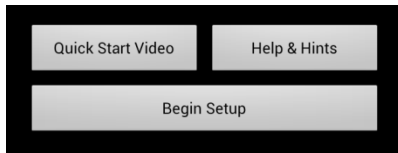
Install Guide - Jabber for Android

Cisco Jabber for Android requires an account to be configured by the system administrator
Cisco Jabber requires the device to be on BSU wireless network.

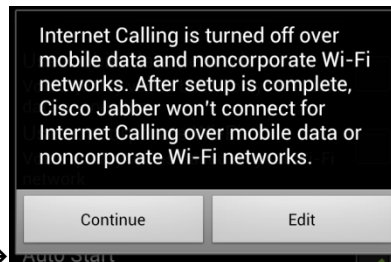
1. Go to the **Play Store** App on your Android phone and search for **Cisco Jabber**



2. Choose the **Jabber** app by Cisco Systems Inc. → Touch **Install** → **Accept and download**
3. After installation completes, open Cisco Jabber → **Accept** the end user agreement
4. **Accept** the end user agreement → Touch **Begin Setup**



5. For **Device ID**, enter the capital letters BOT and then your username (ex. BOTJDOE) → For **Server Address**, enter "callmanager.bsu.edu" → Make sure that **Use mobile data network** and **Use noncorporate Wi-Fi** are unchecked → Check whether or not to have Cisco Jabber startup automatically → Touch **Verify** → Touch **Continue**



6. Touch the Voicemail tab → Choose **Set up Visual Voicemail** → For **Server Name**, enter “unityvoicemail.bsu.edu” → For **Port**, enter “443” → For **Username**, enter your BSU username → For **Password**, enter your BSU password → Touch **Verify**
