

Anatomy of an International Number:

011 + Country Code + City Code + Number

- The length of the phone number varies by country; it's not always 7 digits.

- This web resource allows you to look up International Country Codes and City Codes.

Faxing Tip:

It's best to make an International fax from a machine with a handset. This allows you to listen for the "stuttered dial tone" prompt to enter your PBN.

- Remember – If dialing from the handset on a fax machine, you will need to press the 'Start' button when you hear the fax tone on the other end. Simply hanging up the handset may disconnect the call.
- If the fax machine you are using does not have a handset, you will need to experiment with the number of pauses to insert into the dialed number. The amount of time between the end of the number and the "stuttered dial tone" varies depending on the country being called.
