Provost Terry King convened the meeting at 8:00 a.m.

Terry requested Michael Goldsby to review what he discusses when giving a presentation to outside entities regarding Ball State.

He indicated that the Ball family philosophy and history are important, especially since their giving spirit to the community wasn't absolutely necessary. He asked Kerry Ann McGeary to tell the group why she came to Ball State. Kerry Ann said the plaque on the Beneficence statue on University Avenue affirmed her desire to become a faculty member: "Grow, Evolve, Prosper." This is what she wanted her students to do during and after their college career. She knew she made the right choice.

M. Goldsby added that the theme of "Impact Indiana" is resonating with this group and that is really what the Ball family did. Purdue and IU do not have this type of legacy.

CURRENT THEMES:

- Students we want our student body to be high quality
- Learning Experiences the methods of how we're achieving that (immersive learning was important to the stakeholder groups)
- Faculty & Programs Nationally ranked programs, faculty members, broader theme than that. Broader issues like morale, building community within the institution.
- University Environment physical aspect of institution. Originally meant to be cultural activities, town and gown, etc. But ended up being buildings

The Provost believes the consensus is that these themes are still relevant to the forming of the current plan.

NEW THEMES: (The themes we choose have to drive the strategy)

- Creating Community
- Impact Indiana
- Discordance some from data gathering sessions
- Leadership in Education
- Infrastructure
- Engagement (Stewardship)
- "BSU Experience"
 - o BSU Experience feeds into vision
 - o Themes should drive the strategy, but all be formed by the vision statement. Important for university that discordance can be beneficial, but can drive evolution
