## Charles Evans, *President and CEO, Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago*



Charles L. Evans is the president and chief executive officer of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago. In that capacity, he serves on the Federal Open Market Committee—the Federal Reserve System’s monetary policy-making body.

As head of the Chicago Fed, Evans oversees the work of roughly 1,400 employees in Chicago and Detroit who conduct economic research, supervise financial institutions and provide payment services to commercial banks and the U.S. government.

His personal research has focused on measuring the effects of monetary policy on U.S. economic activity, inflation and financial market prices. It has been published in the *Journal of Political Economy*, *American Economic Review*, *Journal of Monetary Economics*, *Quarterly Journal of Economics* and the *Handbook of Macroeconomics*.

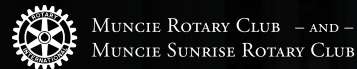
