**Smoking Policy Resolution
Adopted
March 1, 2004**

Whereas Ball State University seeks to provide leadership in environmental matters through numerous greening of the campus initiatives; and,

Whereas the Ball State University Council on the Environment membership represents the university and surrounding Muncie community; and,

Whereas in its role the Council is charged to recommend policies for the good of these communities; and,

Whereas second-hand smoke has become a critical concern for persons on and off campus and, in order to better safeguard human health and reduce risks associated with second-hand smoke,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Council adopt the following motions:

That Ball State University revise its policy on smoking to include a ban on smoking within 30 feet of any university building entrance, air intake, or operable window.

That an educational campaign at Ball State on the hazards of second-hand smoke be mounted; and

That a survey be undertaken of smokers and non-smokers at the BSU campus to determine opinions on the provisions under which smoking is (or should be) permitted at BSU.
