

## **Project Based Consultants**

Ball State University is a public, comprehensive, high-research university located in Muncie, Indiana, USA, with an enrollment of almost 23,000 students. Ball State's Center for International Development manages grants and contracts in the Middle East and South and Central Asia in the field of educational development.

Ball State University (BSU) has been shortlisted to provide consultancy service to the National Institute of Management and Administration (NIMA) in Kabul, Afghanistan, for two years. Funding for this consultancy is provided by the World Bank through the Ministry of Education of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan. Ball State University requires five consultants to join the team.

The project concerns the strengthening of the National Institute of Management and Administration, located in Kabul, Afghanistan, that responds to a government initiative to establish an intensive education program in management and administration to train domestic experts in fields such as management, accounting, procurement, auditing, computers and information technology, English and secretarial functions. Ball State is being asked to provide and implement a sustainable program of academic quality assurance, certification and accreditation, and faculty support and training.
