This can be done on paper or online https://www.bsu.edu/webapps/gradapplication/ It requires three things: ____ Graduate School application form An original transcript from *each* college and university attended - to be sent to the Graduate School Payment of the application fee Second: Apply to the Department of Anthropology for admission to the M.A. program (forms available on the Anthropology website.) Your departmental application will not be processed until we receive word from the Graduate School that you are cleared for admission and all departmental application documents have been received. The departmental application requires the following: ____ Departmental application form Official scores on the Graduate Record Examination General Test (www.ets.org) Graduate admission recommendation forms from three (3) referees with knowledge of your academic (or relevant non-academic) accomplishments and abilities Narrative statement explaining reasons for wanting to pursue graduate study in anthropology at Ball State and the relationship of such study to your longterm goals. Please limit this statement to three double-spaced typed pages or less. _ Vita (résumé), including educational background, employment history, experience in anthropology and/or archaeology, research endeavors, volunteer efforts, professional organization memberships, honors/awards, etc. An original transcript from each college and university attended – to be sent to the Department. ******* Applications are accepted at any time, but if you wish to ensure *full consideration for a graduate assistantship*, all materials should be received by the department by 15 February. **Assistantship applications** also require the following: Graduate Assistantship Application form (link on dept website) One of the three letters of recommendation with the program application should be from a person who

can evaluate your potential as a teaching assistant
