BUTLER UNIVERSITY PREPHARMACY PROGRAM

The suggested plan of study for Ball State students planning to apply to <u>Butler University's</u> College of Pharmacy is listed below. Ball State University does not grant a degree in pharmacy. Students who have earned the prerequisite college credits may be accepted into the professional phase of the Doctor of Pharmacy program. Application to the Butler Pharmacy Professional phase is through PharmCAS (<u>www.pharmcas.org.</u>) The Butler deadline for receipt of application and transcript materials to PharmCAS is February 1. There is no secondary application. Butler requires that all applicants take the Pharmacy College Admissions Test (PCAT). The PCAT should be taken no later than October of the application year. Information on the PCAT can be found at www.PCATweb.info.

Admission to the 4-year professional program is competitive. The minimum overall GPA for consideration is a 3.0 although the mean GPA for admissions in closer to a 3.5. Minimum PCAT scores for consideration should be in the 50^{th} percentile or higher in each subsection.
