


AICP Exam Pass Rate (2004-2011): Ball State University (Master's Degree)



AICP Exam Pass Rate (2004-2007): Ball State University (Master's Degree)





Mean Score for Section I (2008-2011): History, Theory, & Law (Maximum Score = 23) Ball State University (Master's Degree)



Mean Score for Section II (2008-2011): Plan Making & Implementation (Maximum Score = 45) Ball State University (Master's Degree)



Mean Score for Section III (2008-2011): Functional Areas of Practice (Maximum Score = 38) Ball State University (Master's Degree)



Mean Score for Section IV (2008-2011): Spatial Areas of Practice (Maximum Score = 22) Ball State University (Master's Degree)




