However, since the verification process may be time consuming, your opportunity to receive such things as test accommodations in a given semester may be affected if you choose to wait to begin the process.

When DSD receives this self-disclosure form, you will be mailed a verification form for the appropriate licensed professional to complete, verifying your disability.
