

The Jennifer Hinderliter Memorial Scholarship

Name: The Jennifer Hinderliter Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Jennifer Hinderliter who died from a tragic automobile accident on January 12, 2002. Jennifer received a Bachelor of Arts in Telecommunications – News Option in 2001 from Ball State University. In September of 2001, Jennifer moved to Montana to pursue her dream as a news reporter and anchor with KRTV.

Date: This scholarship was established in 2002.

Amount: \$1000 for 2007

Purpose: The purpose of the scholarship is to provide scholarships to incoming freshmen from the inner city majoring in Telecommunications at Ball State University.

Preferences: Preferences for student selection are as follows:

- 1) Undergraduate students majoring in telecommunications.
- 2) Students from inner city high schools.
- 3) Preference shall be given to incoming freshmen and transfer students, however sophomores, juniors and seniors are eligible.
- 4) Students who have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 5) The scholarship may be renewed at the discretion of the scholarship committee.

In compliance with federal regulations, if applicable, awards will be made without regard to age, race, creed, color, religion, physical or mental disability, sex, national origin, ancestry, or sexual orientation.

To apply:

- Type a letter of application describing your high school activities and your desire for a career in the telecommunications industry. In the spirit of the established scholarship, your letter should clearly reflect your inner city high school experiences. Your letter should include your name, social security number, street address, phone number, and email (if available).
- Include a letter of acceptance from Ball State University.
- Include an original high school transcript with at least a 3.0 out of 4.0 GPA.
- Include one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or administrator
