## Tuition

### A. Basic Undergraduate Tuition

Applies to All Undergraduate Students taking courses on the main Ball State campus, Independent Learning, off-campus, short-term, online, or distance education courses.

0-11 credit hours	\$257 per credit hour
12-18 credit hours	\$3,341 flat rate
19+ credit hours	\$3,341 flat rate + \$257 for each credit hour over 18

### Indiana Residents

Applies to legal residents of the state of Indiana. To calculate rate include applicable fees from C. Student Services Fee + D. Mandatory Fees + E. Program Fees + F. Course Fees.

0-11 credit hours	\$257 per credit hour
12-18 credit hours	\$3,341 flat rate
19+ credit hours	\$3,341 flat rate + \$257 for each credit hour over 18

### B. Non-Resident Tuition

Applies Only to Students who are not legal residents of the state of Indiana. To calculate rate, include applicable fees from C. Student Services Fee + D. Mandatory Fees + E. Program Fees + F. Course Fees
